Directions: Following are four characters from the novel. In the bubble blanks, write the character's **thoughts** as he/she considers what is happening on the page indicated. I have provided an example on the back of this sheet.

1.



Mildred (pages 76-77)

A large, empty, rounded rectangular bubble with a tail pointing to the circular illustration of Mildred Montag, intended for writing her thoughts.

Guy Montag (p. 78)

A large, empty, rounded rectangular bubble with a tail pointing to the circular illustration of Guy Montag, intended for writing his thoughts.

Mr. Faber (p. 82)
